



How to search





SEARCH BAR

Enter the location, title no, postcode or company name you want to see on the map and click Search.




NO NEED TO SEARCH

If you don't have an exact title/location in mind, you can zoom in to any location and browse around the map.



SEARCH RESULTS


A blue Centre Pin is dropped at the centre of your search area and all freehold titles are outlined in white.



FILTER YOUR RESULTS

By default, every title is highlighted in your search area when you zoom in. If you want to search for titles with certain criteria, use Filters (Page 5).


TITLES

Each title, as defined by the HM Land Registry, is outlined in white. Simply click a title to view the **Info Panel** (page 7).



LABELS

Easily toggle Google Maps labels (e.g. road names, places on interest) and saved site markers on/off in the i menu.



MAP VIEWS


Click to switch between different Map Views:

- Google Satelite (Default) Realistic view
- OS MasterMap Clear title boundaries
- Bing Birds-Eye 3D perspective

PERSONALISATION

Click the menu (top right) to manage your **Account.** Here you can change the colour of the title polygons. Click **Save & Close** to save your preferences.


SEARCH WITH FILTERS

Use **Filters** to narrow down your search. This will highlight properties specific to you or your clients' requirements.



MOVE AROUND THE MAP

Drag the map to any location and Nimbus will highlight all properties matching your filters in this new location.



Site sizes - Total area of a site boundary.

Building footprint - Total area contained within the exterior walls of a building's ground floor.

Use types - Categorisation of a property's current use class (e.g. retail, land, residential, offices).

EPC rating - Classification of a building's energy performance rating.







Understand the information panel







INFORMATION PANEL

Clicking on any title reveals the **Information Panel**. This is your one-stop-shop for information about a property/title.



TOGGLE THE PANEL

Open and close the information panel using the **Info Panel** icon in the left-hand toolbar.

THE INFORMATION

- Title number & address.
- Use types, classes & commercial uses.
- Ownership information In commercial ownership you'll see the company that owns it as well as their estate.
- HM Land Registry documents In private ownership, you can purchase HMLR docs to view ownership directly in the platform.
- Add sites to your Workflow (Page 13).

- Site area, building heights, EPC rating.
- Sizes & rates assessments.
- Price paid data & indexed current values.
- Availability Is it currently on the market?
 (commercial only).
- Planning histories Plus any applications in the local area.
- Environmental considerations e.g. flood zones, greenbelt).
- Other Listed status, local population.

NEW LOCATION ANALYSIS

Click **Location Analysis** to visually understand any site and its surrounding area. Each tool adds layers (overlays) to the map for simple, fast analysis.

2

CATEGORIES

Within Location Analysis, you'll see categories for assessing Planning Policy, Market, and Technical (see below), Sales Comparables (page 9) & Planning (page 10).

1. PLANNING POLICY

The Housing Delivery Test overlay shows how well councils are performing against housing targets. Reduce your planning risk with overlays for Flood Maps, Listed Buildings, Green Belt & more.

2. MARKET


Commercial Availability shows company-owned properties currently on the market. You can also assess local Residential Values and Avg. Yields, and plot every licenced UK HMO on the map!


3. TECHNICAL

View **Traffic Flow** reports for UK roads - great for retail development!
Toggle on **Built-Up Areas** to highlight urban areas, or the **Substations** overlay to locate electrical substations.





RESIDENTIAL SALES COMPARABLES

Works in the same way as the Resi Comps with the addition of **use types** also being displayed on the map with prices. Click the prices for more information.






FILTER YOUR COMPARABLES



PLANNING OVERLAY


Navigate to **Location Analysis** > **Planning** to toggle on the planning overlay. When turned on, you can easily see every planning application in an area directly on the map.

DISPLAY ON MAP

Planning applications are displayed as **Dots** on the map. The larger the dot, the larger the scheme. You can click on a dot to view the application details.

FILTER PLANNING APPLICATIONS


Click the arrow next to the planning tool to filter applications by **planning authority**, **application keywords**, **outcome**, or use our preset filters.




Export commercial buildings currently on the market in any area (updated daily with listings from the top 400 surveyors). Click the arrow next to **Commercial Availability**.






WORKFLOW

Manage your pipeline within your secure **Workflow.** To view your Workflow, click the Workflow icon in the left menu bar.

Workflow is a fully customisable pipeline. Simply **drag & drop** sites across your stages, and **add stages** to reflect your processes.



3 BULK ACTIONS

Perform bulk actions (e.g. Download multiple HMLR documents) by clicking on the **three dots** and selecting **bulk actions**.
